PARKING INFORMATION

The Washington University Danforth Campus is situated across from Forest Park and is bounded by Skinker Boulevard to the east, Forsyth Boulevard to the south, Big Bend Boulevard to the west, and Millbrook Boulevard/Forest Park Parkway to the north. **Bus and car drivers are asked to enter campus via Forest Park Parkway.** Please see link of campus map:

Cars and buses MUST allow students to disembark at the foot of Brookings Steps. No students should disembark at Mallinckrodt Bus Plaza or another location on campus.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING PARKING REGULATIONS:

Cars, minivans or SUVs

- Due to the limited availability of parking spaces on campus, please limit the number of cars that will need to park on campus to the bare minimum.
- Cars, minivans, or SUVs may park on the parking lots to the east of Hoyt Drive in parking areas marked as "Yellow Parking" only.
- Drivers must obtain a day parking permit; we will mail these to you with our last mailing before German Day. If you have not requested or received a parking permit, you may get one from the Reception Committee at the top of Brookings Steps on the morning of the event.
- Parking permits must be displayed prominently and have the correct **month, day and year** scratched off.

Buses

- Due to the limited availability of parking spaces on campus, have your buses return to your school if at all possible for the duration of German Day events.
- Due to changes in parking on Danforth Campus, buses will be unable to park in any of the Danforth campus parking lots.
- Once buses have unloaded, any bus wanting to park and stage, will proceed to lot 61 at West Campus. This map will assist the driver as to the location of lot 61, http://parking.wustl.edu/parkingmap_2010.pdf. (It is the same map as the one attached, just with parking areas highlighted in yellow.)
- Bob Sparks from the office of Parking and Transportation Services will be present on lot 61 to arrange the buses as they arrive. Any bus not staging on lot 61, upon returning to campus, must return to lot 61 – not the loading area on Hoyt.
- Eva Russo or Empress Sanders will be provided with a radio to use to communicate with Bob. If teachers contact Eva or Empress (either in Ridgley 317 or on their cell phones: 818-416-0724/314-323-0572). When they are ready to leave campus, either will contact Mr. Sparks, who will then send the buses to campus. All buses will be dispatched to Hoyt, in an orderly manner, to pick up guests.
